Ramona Convent Secondary School hired Slater Builders as the general contractor for our \$4.3 million 6,000 square foot science building. Our work began with a \$300,000 site preparation project involving relocation of utility lines in July of 2007. Actual construction of the building began in January, 2008 and was completed on time for the dedication of the building in November, 2008.
